


NV Blanc de Blancs Adelaide Hills

Winemaking Background

'Blanc de Blancs' is a French term meaning "whitest of whites" and is commonly used to describe a sparkling wine made from 100% Chardonnay grapes, rather than the more traditional Chardonnay and Pinot Noir blends.

Tasting Notes

Colour: Medium straw with fresh green hue.

Aroma: Delightful apple and zesty lime notes flourish on the bouquet.

Palate: Fresh and vivacious, nuances of refreshing lemon and stone-fruit flourish in this bright and lively wine, which finishes with a clean acidity and elegant bead.

Food Match

Served chilled with some fresh Coffin Bay oysters and a squeeze of lime.

Alc: 12% pH: 3.08
